Not all the information collected via GIAS will be published, but all will be held encrypted securely by the department. Boards should make it clear in their Code of Conduct that **information about each person will be published on their website and via GIAS**. Anyone failing to provide information to enable the Board to fulfil their responsibilities may be in breach of the Code of Conduct and as a result be bringing the Board into disrepute. Maintained school Boards should consider suspending Governors, while academy trust Boards, Members or other appointing bodies should consider removing such individuals.
